YOUR WHITE RIVER: *Hamilton County*

The White River Vision Plan is a joint effort between the City of Indianapolis and Hamilton County Tourism. in partnership with Visit Indy's philanthropic arm, Tourism Tomorrow, Inc. the goal is to develop a comprehensive and coordinated regional, community-driven plan to enhance 58 miles of the White River in Marion and Hamilton counties.

The plan will identify accessible, recreational, and cultural environments that encourages a unique sense of place for the community as a whole, similar to finished "river city" developments in cities like Nashville, Columbus, Chicago, and Cincinnati, but more expansive and across county lines.

THE WHITE RIVER VISION PLAN WILL PROMOTE:

- Access to the White River for residents and visitors
- The environmental value and ecological quality of the river corridor
- Connection to attractions, arts and entertainment venues, hiking and biking trails, and neighborhoods
- Educational and thematic recreational water experiences

Community participation and feedback are important to create an ecologically and economically healthy corridor that weaves neighborhoods, institutions and destinations that amplify the natural beauty of the region.

We hope you will share your visions, needs, and desires for the White River Vision Plan through a series of public meetings, signing up for news alert bulletins, and through other engagement opportunities. Feedback will help develop a vision statement, goals, and objectives to achieve a community-driven vision.
