On **September 22, 2026**, we will coordinate a presentation at Conner Prairie featuring an array of contestants and a panel of judges made up of local economic development leaders. The judges will select winners and award prizes, recognizing those Creatives who present the most innovative, effective, and or inspiring ideas.
